

Stand still for polite greeting (& conformation & obedience stand for exam)

In public, keep treats in front of pup's nose as people greet him- hold the pup or stand on the leash.

Can work through these steps with pup on paw targets also

	<b>Prevent Jumping up-</b> Stand on the leash, tether with a harness during a training session, or put the pup behind a gate or other barrier. Hold puppy for greetings during socialization and keep treats in front of his nose.
	<b>'4 on the floor' gets rewarded</b>
	With puppy tethered or behind a barrier- Mark and drop/toss treats on the floor anytime the pup has 4 on the floor (stand). Try to be as rapid fire as possible.
	Wait for stillness for the count of "1" before you mark, reward.
	Wait for "1 &" of stillness to mark/motivate- be sure treats are on the floor
	"1 & 2" of stillness
	Repeat above with exciting verbals
	Repeat above with physical prompts to jump up
	Repeat with out of sight brief duration
	Add exciting return
	Add physical contact, gentle/brief at first, work up to excited petting
	Repeat with no barrier. Ignore/no contact if puppy jumps up
	Practice with other people who can follow directions
	Take a few steps away and hold out a treat in my hand. Standing still brings him the treat.
	Gradually build up distance. Standing still brings me closer, anything else moves me away.
	Take 2-3 steps away and gradually increase the enticement of the treat. Reward stand
	Gradually build distance and enticement levels (toys, excited language, etc.)
	Add contact/petting, at first during the treat, then before the treat
	Increase excitement of petting & praise
	Repeat in several different environments
	Repeat with trainers that can follow directions
